To the Honourable Justice of the Peace:

I am writing to explain my circumstances and to respectfully request consideration for a payment plan that will allow me to address my outstanding fines and work toward reinstating my driver's license.

As a teenager, I grew up in Brampton in a low-income household with my father. We relied on government assistance and had very limited guidance or structure. During that time, I made poor decisions and was heavily influenced by negative peer behavior. I began driving without a license as a minor, believing it was necessary to find and maintain work, but without fully understanding the long-term consequences of my actions.

During that period of my life, I also struggled to maintain steady employment. My lack of maturity, combined with my poor decisions, made it difficult to keep a job and move forward in a stable way.

At age 18, I became a father. My first son has autism and is non-verbal, and I felt pressure to provide for him. Instead of correcting my behavior, I continued to make poor choices and accumulated fines related to driving without a license. In 2017, after being pulled over and informed that I owed approximately \$100,000 in fines, I stopped driving entirely. That moment was a turning point for me. Since then, I have not driven and have tried to live responsibly within the limits of my situation.

Now, at 29 years old, I am a father of two. My second son, born in 2022, has a serious medical condition ([REDACTED]) and requires frequent specialist appointments across Dufferin County, the GTA, and Hamilton. Not having a license has made it extremely difficult to support my family. I rely heavily on my wife and others for transportation, which has placed emotional and logistical strain on my household.

In contrast to my earlier years, I have now built stability in my employment. I have been with my current employer for two and a half years, and I take pride in my work. My role requires me to drive as part of my duties, and a valid driver's license is essential for me to perform my work, maintain my employment, and provide for my family. I value my job and want to continue growing with the company. However, my ability to advance and increase my income is limited without a valid driver's license. With the rising cost of living, this has made it increasingly difficult to provide for my family and meet my responsibilities.

I fully accept responsibility for my past actions. I understand that my decisions led to these consequences, and I regret the choices I made. Over the past several years, I have demonstrated change by no longer driving illegally and focusing on supporting my family in lawful ways.

I am now taking the necessary steps, through legal assistance, to resolve my outstanding fines. I am requesting the opportunity to enter into a reasonable payment plan so that I can begin repaying what I owe while also working toward reinstating my license. This would allow me to become a more active and reliable parent, a better employee, and a responsible member of my community.

I am committed to making things right and moving forward in a positive and lawful direction.
